



## Frequently Asked Questions

**When is the tournament?** The NJ Golden Gloves will be held every Friday and Saturday evening during the month of June.

**Where will the tournament be?** The NJ Golden Gloves tournament will be held at various locations throughout the state. Please check the schedule on our website for times and locations.

USA Boxing are a New Jersey resident with proof of residency and meet all those requirements are eligible to compete. Boxers who are under the age of 18 are invited to enter the FUTURE STARS Program. This is different than the NJGG tournament in those boxers are pre-matched by weight, age, and experience level rather than the restrictive restraints of true tournament competition.

**Must all boxers be clean shaven in order to compete?** All **Open Class** boxers must be clean shaven in order to compete, the NJ State Tournament is considered an advancing tournament, therefore all open class boxers must be clean shaven. In addition, all boxers in the open class must compete both locally and nationally with open face (no cheek protectors) head gear.

**How do I get an application?** You can download the appropriate application from the front page of our website.

**Is there an entry fee?** Yes, there is an entry fee for the adult NJGG Tournament. This year the fee will be \$20.00 per entry. There is no entry fee for the Future Stars program.

**What are the weight classes and divisions?** This year the tournament will be contesting the following weight classes: **Male: 112, 125, 139, 147, 156, 165, 176, 189, 203, 203+**

**Female: 106, 114, 125, 132, 139, 146, 154, 165, 178, 178+**

**Future Stars will be pre-matched at the weight they put on the application.**

There will be 3 divisions to enter this year: Sub Novice (2 bouts or less) , (Novice 3-9 bouts) and open class (10 bouts or more). Sub Novice, and novice division brackets may be contested as a double elimination tournament, open class will be single elimination.

**How do I Qualify for the National Golden Gloves Tournament of Champions?** All open class boxers with 10 or more bouts who win the NJ Golden Gloves State Tournament are eligible. Only open class boxers with ten or more bouts may participate at the National Tournament. Walk over champions at the local level will not qualify for the National NJ Team.
